



## Application to have a name reserved for a political party

Section 399.1 of the Act respecting elections and referendums in municipalities stipulates that before filing an application for authorization, the leader of a party may apply in writing to the Chief Electoral Officer to have a name reserved for a period not exceeding six months. The application must specify the municipality in whose territory the party intends to carry on its activities and the council for which it intends to present candidates. A party having reserved a name may, however, specify another name in its application for authorization.
